













Print two sets of cards and cut out along the solid black lines. Shuffle the cards and lay them face down, in rows. The youngest player goes first. Play then continues in a clockwise direction. On each turn, a player turns over any two cards (one at a time) and keeps them if the cards match. If they match a pair, they get to keep the cards, and that player gets another turn. When a player turns over two cards that do not match, those cards are turned face down again (in the same position) and it is the next player's turn. The trick is to remember which cards are where. The person with the most pairs at the end of the game wins.
